



## Southeast Georgia Fellowship of Christian Athletes Camp Scholarship Guidelines

SEGA FCA is a not-for profit ministry. As such, we operate as good stewards of the monies of donors who fund this ministry for 12 months of ministry to Camps, Campuses, Coaches and Communities. Camps are one-fourth of the ministry that takes place over a year of ministry. We are striving to send as many coaches, athletes and teams to camp as possible from our seven county area (Berrien, Brooks, Clinch, Cook, Echols, Lanier and Lowndes Counties). These guidelines are only applicable to our area counties and will enable us to continue to ensure that our teams/athletes are able to go to camp while remaining good stewards of the resources needed to fund this ministry for an entire year.

### Camp Scholarship Guidelines:

- **All deposits are to be paid by athletes or team coach in order to secure your place at camp.**
- If the team/athlete is able to pay 100% of their camp expenses, praise the Lord! This will allow us to help less fortunate teams/athletes in lower income communities.
- If **individual team members** need scholarship aid, the Coach and Area Director can meet to negotiate aid. Coaches will need to contact the Area Director no later than one month prior to the camp departure date.
- If an **entire team** needs scholarship aid, the following aid is available:
  - One third of the total camp cost per player can be SEGA FCA scholarship aid.
  - One third of the total cost could be the responsibility of the team member.
  - The final third of the cost could be the responsibility of the school or booster club.
  - The above options are **only suggestions**. SEGA FCA will scholarship 1/3 of the total camp cost and the remainder of the cost will be up to the coach's plan.
- All camps will be paid in full **no later** than one week prior to the camp departure date.

NOTE: Scholarships are provided on a need-by-need basis. Scholarships are only provided to Athletes and Teams within the seven county Southeast Georgia FCA Area. If you are an athlete or coach from outside the SEGA FCA Area, contact your Area Director or Area Representative for possible scholarship aid.
